Snow White and the Seven Dwarves

Using this fairy tale as a theme, try some of these activities:-

Maths	Explore how many ways to make 7 eg $2+5$ or $6+1$. Ensure the children understand that it is the same if the numbers are reversed eg $4=3=7$ and $3+4=7$ Make up some word problems linked to the 7 dwarves. If Grumpy found 10 diamonds and then Happy found 2 more, how many would they have altogether?
Speaking and listening	Find new words and use them in sentences. Discuss the words in the story of Snow White. Help your child to take turns in a conversation. Encourage them to ask a questions linked to what you have just been talking about.
Literacy	Use the phonic sound chart to write words and sentences. Remember to start with a capital letter and end with a full stop. Remind your child to leave finger spaces between words. Draw a character from the story and label them- e.g. pointy hat, red beard. Describe a character Make a list of all the treasure belonging to the dwarves.
Reading	Read or tell the story of Snow White and the 7 dwarves. Talk about the story. Discuss why the Queen is so wicked. Make up an alternative ending. Draw a story map of the story.
Understanding of the world (Science)	Make a map of the forest with the 7 dwarves house, the mine and the castle. What other things could you include in your map.
Art	Draw, paint, colour in, make playdough. Practice cutting out. Draw the treasure that the 7 dwarves find in the mines
Being active	Watch Joe Wicks PE workout at 9am daily Practice catching and throwing Learn to skip. Time yourself jogging on the spot. Record how many minutes you can jog for. Can you do more each day?
Turn taking and getting on with others	The mirror in Snow White says that The Queen is the fairest of them all. What makes you special? What are your good qualities? Look in a mirror and very carefully draw your face. Now think about all the things you are good at and label your picture. When Snow White was at home by herself, she shouldn't have opened the door to speak to the wicked queen. What things do you do to keep yourself safe every day? E.g. not open the door without an adult being there, looking both ways when you cross the road, not touching hot things like the kettle or the cooker. Make a poster with your ideas.
