

You should be reading for at least 25 minutes each day.

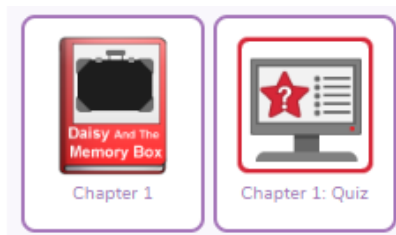

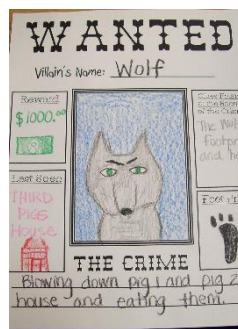


Fun Activity of the Week


