We are delighted that over the next few weeks we will have members of the **Jacksons Lane Community Centre**, coming to teach circus skills to some of our children.

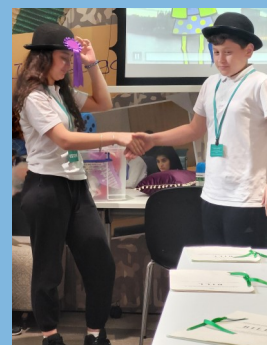
