LONDON

London is where we are - immersing the children in their locality. It provides a sense of identity and connection to our local area, providing the opportunity to explore the past, present and future of London, Haringey, Wood Green.

JOURNEYS

Journeys is a vast theme, ranging from concepts such as physical journeys, personal journeys and growth, migration/ refugees/ asylum, a journey through a particular place and many more concepts that have developed or been on a 'journey' of some sort. It also encompasses the children's journeys through education and Alexandra.



INNOVATION AND CHANGE

Innovation and change investigates significant people, ideas and inventions which have inspired change. It considers past civilisations such as The Stone Age and The Romans and the changes they implemented which have influenced modern Britain. It also considers how innovation can lead to change and examines how change can be managed e.g. Democracy, inspirational leaders who have created change and significant movements such as The Civil Rights Movement and The Suffragettes.

OUR EARTH AND SUSTAINABILITY

Our Earth and Sustainability ranges from two key aspects of our planet: the human and physical elements such as volcanoes, rivers and different biomes and being sustainable citizens. This equips children with the knowledge and skills to act as global citizens and take care of the planet for the future of our planet.



IDENTITY AND POWER

Identity and Power is all about investigating one's identity and the power of individuals. It enables children to recognise and celebrate their own identity and power in addition to significant people, especially marginalised groups. As children progress through Alexandra, their discussions within this theme will consider people in power and the impact these people have had on society throughout history, examining multiple perspectives and sources of information.
