In September 2023, members of the Alexandra community, including staff, children and parents, completed a values survey and told us what was important to them.

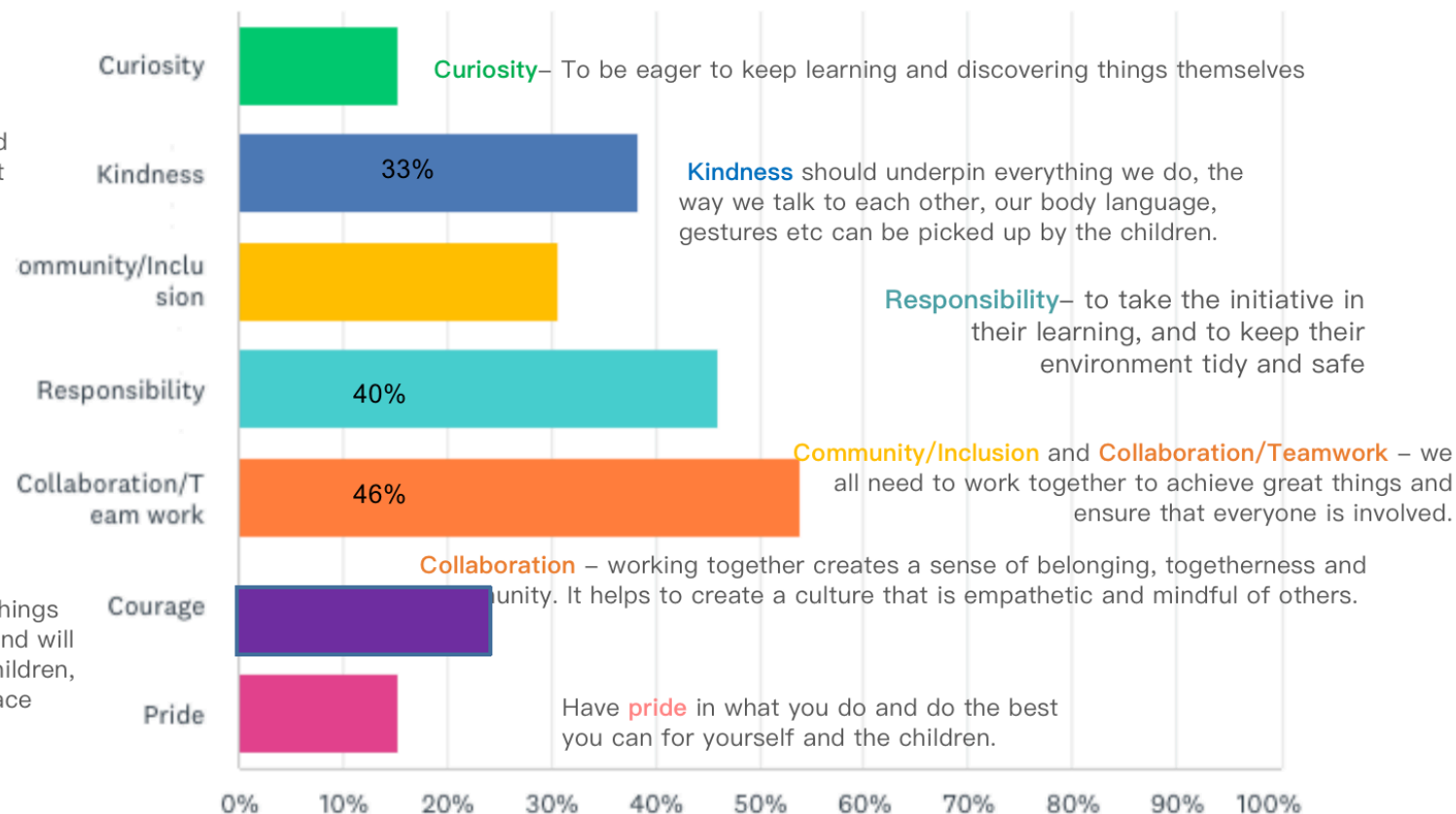
Which of these proposed new values to you most connect with?

Curiosity – By being curious and working together we can get better awareness and build stronger support, feeling each other's support.



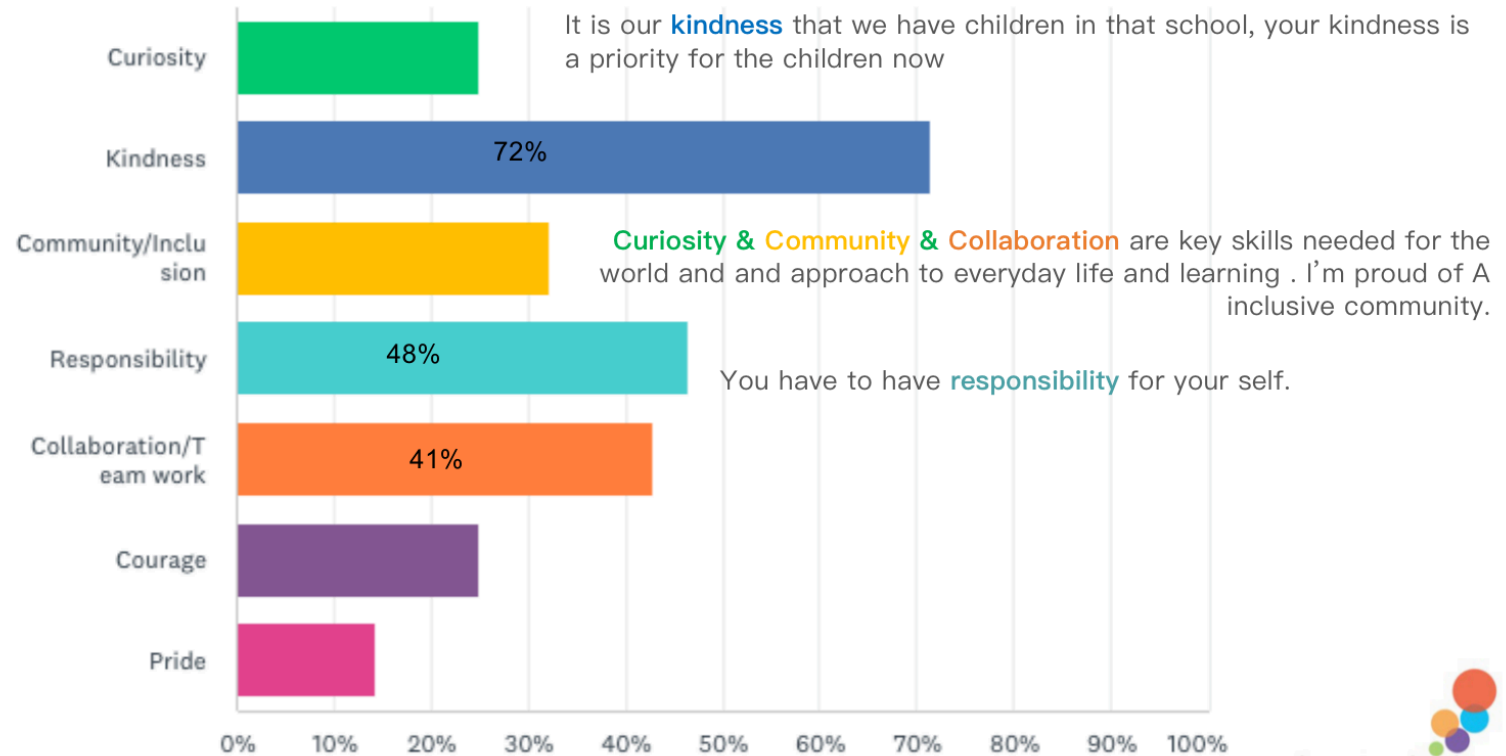
Which of these proposed new values to you most connect with?

You have to have **curiosity** to push yourself to do much more things.

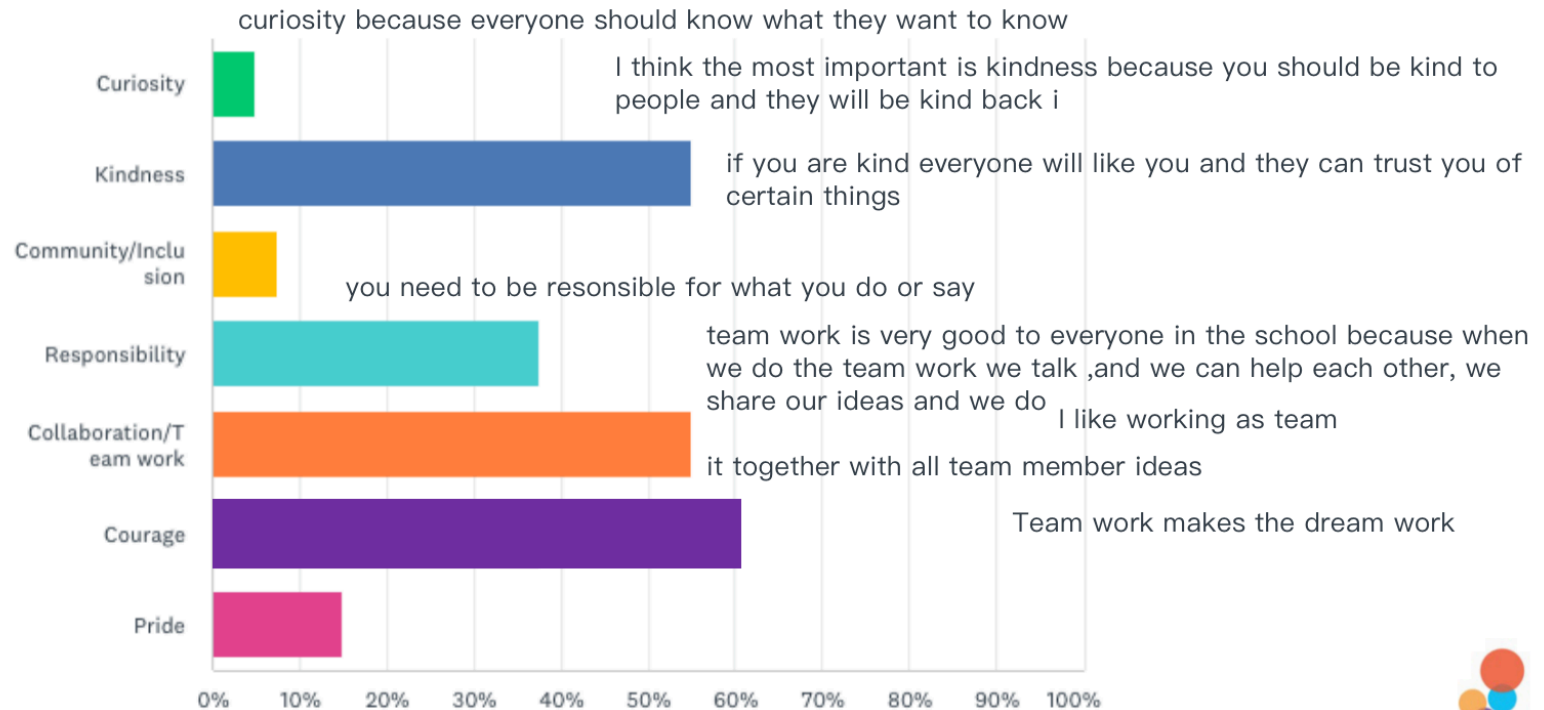
You have to show **kindness** in every single day.

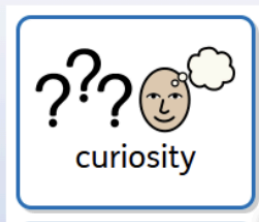

In September 2024, with the help of our school community, we agreed on the following four values of **Curiosity, Courage, Responsibility and Kindness**.

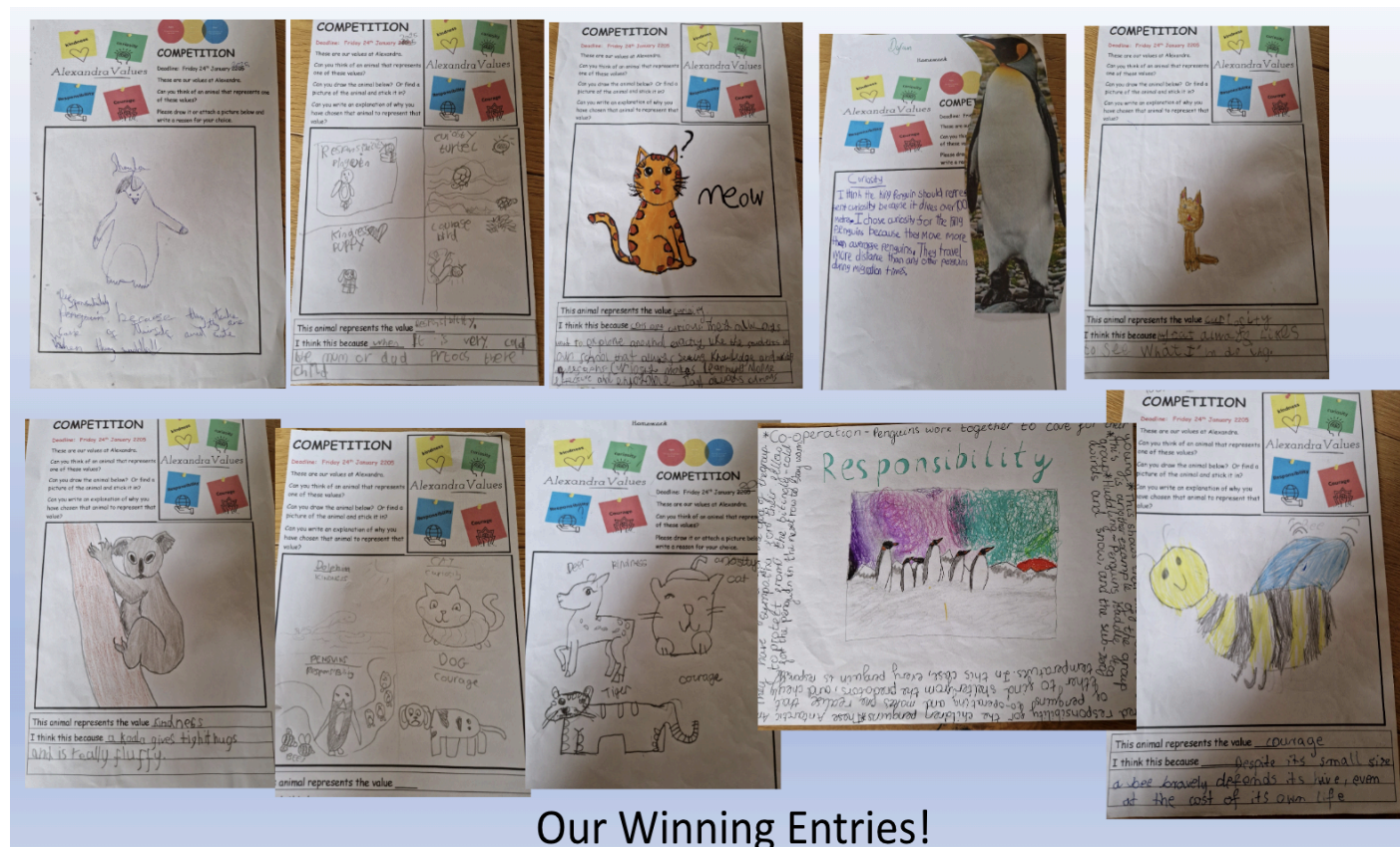


In January 2025, we asked members of the school community to enter a **competition** to design the animals to represent our values.



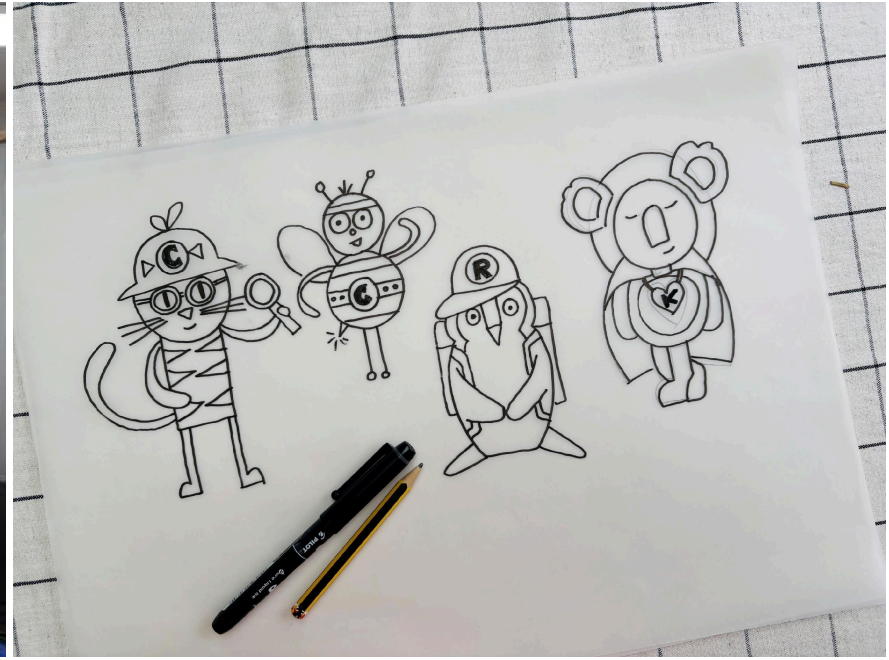
Chose an animal to represent one of our school values.
